- *Pathology of privilege : racism, white denial & the costs of inequality* / Tim Wise; produced by Sut Jhally. (57 min) 2008 (also titled *Time Wise: On White Privilege*) Offers a unique, inside-out view of race and racism in America. Wise explains white privilege and the damage it does not only to people of color, but to white people as well. This is an introduction to the social construction of racial identities, and a new tool for exploring the often invoked concept of white privilege.
- *Mirrors of privilege : making whiteness visible* / directed by Shakti Butler and Rick Butler. (50 min) 2006 Up close and personal stories of white activists and their ongoing journeys of transformation. Participants talk about being unconscious about their learned and internalized sense of white supremacy. They share what actions they took to move through the common first stages of denial, defensiveness, guilt, fear and shame into making solid commitments towards ending racism. Uses art, theatre, movement, photographs, spoken word, music, historical sources, and video archives.
- *Home of the brave* / directed, produced, and written by Paola di Florio ; produced by Nancy Dickenson. DVD 2005 (74 min) Viola Liuzzo, a 39-year-old wife and mother of five, was the only white woman killed during the civil rights movement. Powerful and poignant documentary tells Liuzzo's tragic story.
